

A GUIDE FOR PARENTS

Welcome to Volusia County Schools Instructional Management Systems (VIMS). This system provides you access to your child's attendance, grades and assignments 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, from any computer with an Internet connection. This access requires a confidential username and password that will be provided to you by your child's school.

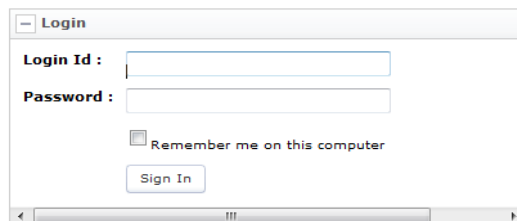
Below are step-by-step instructions to create your new account:

STEP 1 – ACCESS

1. To access the Volusia County Instructional Management System (VIMS) go to the Volusia County Schools Web site at: <http://myvolusiaschools.org>
2. Click on the **Parents** icon located on the right side of the page.
3. Under the **Toolbox** tab, click **Volusia Instructional Mgmt System (VIMS)**.
4. The VIMS Webpage will be displayed. Click the **Gradebook** tile located in the center of the page.




5. The **log-in** screen will be displayed.

Password are case sensitive. If you have already established your account enter the username and password you set up,

7. Click **Sign-in**.
8. If you are logging in for the first time the following password prompt will be displayed. Enter the **Old Password** from the parent letter, a **New Password** and click **Change Password**.



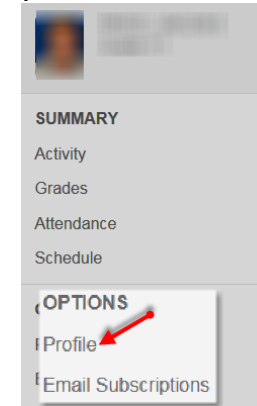
IMPORTANT NOTE: Please keep in mind that your password is case sensitive. Keep your password confidential. Your New Password will not take effect until you logout and log back in.

9. The **GradeBook Home Page** will be displayed.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Before continuing we recommend that you add an email address to your account. Please follow the directions outlined in Step 2.

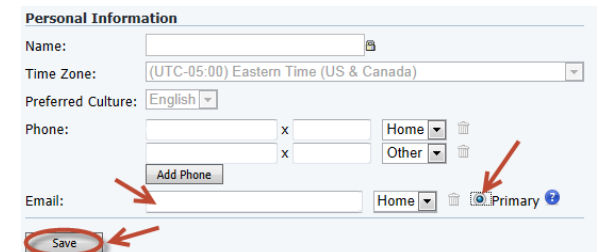
STEP 2 – ADD YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS

1. Under **Options**, click **Profile**.



2. Your **Personal Information** will be displayed. Enter your **Email**, click the **primary radio button** next to the email address you just entered and click **Save**.

IMPORTANT NOTE: It is important that you select the radio button next to the email address you use. This enables you to use the "Forgot Password" feature.



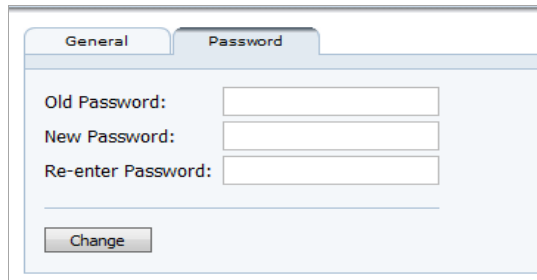
NOTE: You may add multiple email addresses.

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STEP 3 – TO CHANGE YOUR PASSWORD

This step can be by-passed if you have already changed your password. You may follow this step any time you want to change your password.

1. On the **Personal Information** screen, click the **Password** tab.

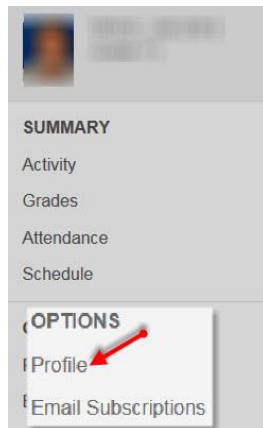

2. Enter your **Old Password**, enter your **New Password**, **Re-enter New Password** and click **Change**.

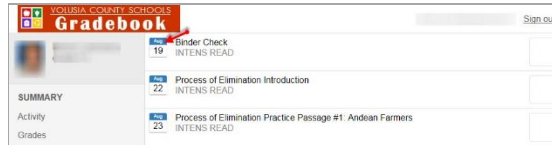
STEP 4 – STUDENT SUMMARY REPORTS

1. To view your child's attendance, click the **Attendance Summary** link. Your child's Attendance will be color coded for quick viewing.
2. Click on the **Grade Summary** link to view your child's grades by course.
3. Click on the **Schedule Summary** link to view your child's schedule. The

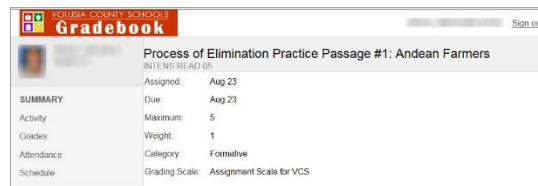


Teacher Email is also displayed on this screen. You may email teachers with an established email account by clicking envelope logo next to the teachers' name.

4. To view your child's Assignments click on the **Activity** link. Your child's Overdue Assignments, Assignment Due Today and Future Assignments Due will be displayed.



5. To view the detail of the assignment, click on the assignment.



STEP 6 – OPTIONS


1. Click the **Profile** link to change or add a Phone Number or an Email address.

IMPORTANT NOTE: This does NOT change your child's official school record. All changes must be submitted in writing to your child's school.

2. If you would like to receive daily or weekly email notifications regarding your child's attendance or grade information, click on the **Email Subscription** link.
3. Choose your subscriptions by clicking in the appropriate checkbox(s) next to the notification(s) you would like to receive. Click **SAVE**.

If **Grade Summary and/or Assignments Notification** is selected, you will receive the notification on the day(s) selected.

STEP 7 – SIGN OUT

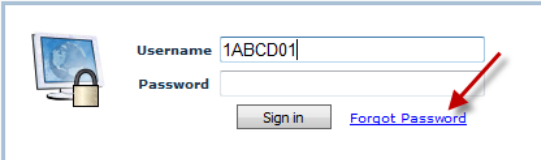
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1. When you have completed viewing your child's information, click the **Sign out** link located at the top right of the page.

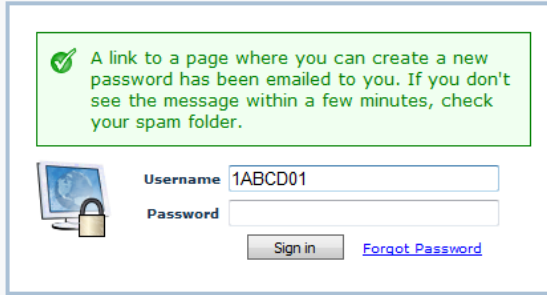
1. **What do I do if I forgot my password?** If you have established an email address for your account, click [Parent: Forgot Password?](#) Link on the Home Page.

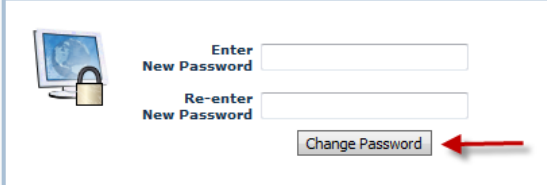

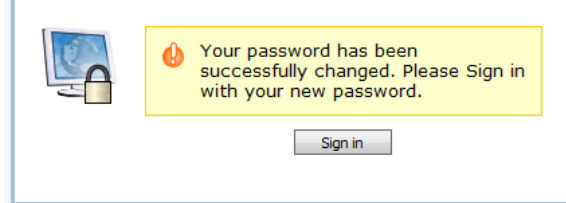
